MINISTERIAL INTRODUCTION COURSE

Pre-requisite to taking this course is the applicant must have obtained and present a copy of their Fellowship Certificate showing they are a member in good standing with their home church and of the P.A.W. Council. Such documentation certifies you are recognized as a minister and serve in your local assembly.

The Board of Bishops of the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc. has legislated that successful completion of this certificate course is required for all persons desiring to be licensed. The 3-month course is course is divided into the following sections:

- I. Basic Doctrine: An in-dept examination of the basic tenets of the Apostolic faith as revealed in the writings of the Old and New Testaments. The two required textbooks are *Apostolic Primer* and *Fundamentals of the Apostolic Faith*

- II. Bible Introduction: A general review of the Old and New Testaments. The required textbook is *Exploring the Basics of the Bible*

- III. Your Organization: A comprehensive view of the history and operation of the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc. the textbook needed is “*Excerpts From the P.A.W. Minute Book*”

- IV. Ministerial Introduction Workbook: Includes general instructions and answer sheets for each course section.
