ORDINATION PREPARATION COURSE

The Board of Bishops of the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc. has legislated that successful completion of this certificate course is required for all persons desiring to be ordained. The 6-month course is course is divided into the following sections:

- I. Human Development: An overview of the physical, psychological and spiritual development of men and women from birth through childhood, adolescence, young adulthood and maturity to the end of life. The focus is on the maturation process, crises and vital choices inherent in each growth level with emphasis on the effects of society and culture upon human development. The textbook used is *Understanding People*
- II. Christian Discipling: A general review of effective witnessing and soul winning techniques with additional information on the gifts of the Spirit. The two required textbooks are *Your Ministry of Evangelism* and *Birth of the Spirit*
- III. Christian Pastorate: An exploration of the origin and significance of Christian pastor. It also deals with a pastor's commission, preparation, pulpit conduct and personal life. Church administration is also a focal point. The needed textbook is: *Scriptural View of the Christian Pastorate*
- IV. History of Pentecost: A comprehensive history of the twentieth-century Pentecostals and the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, 1901-1930. The textbook used is *Early Pentecostal Revival*
- V. Ordination Preparation Workbook: Includes general instructions and answer sheets for each course section.
